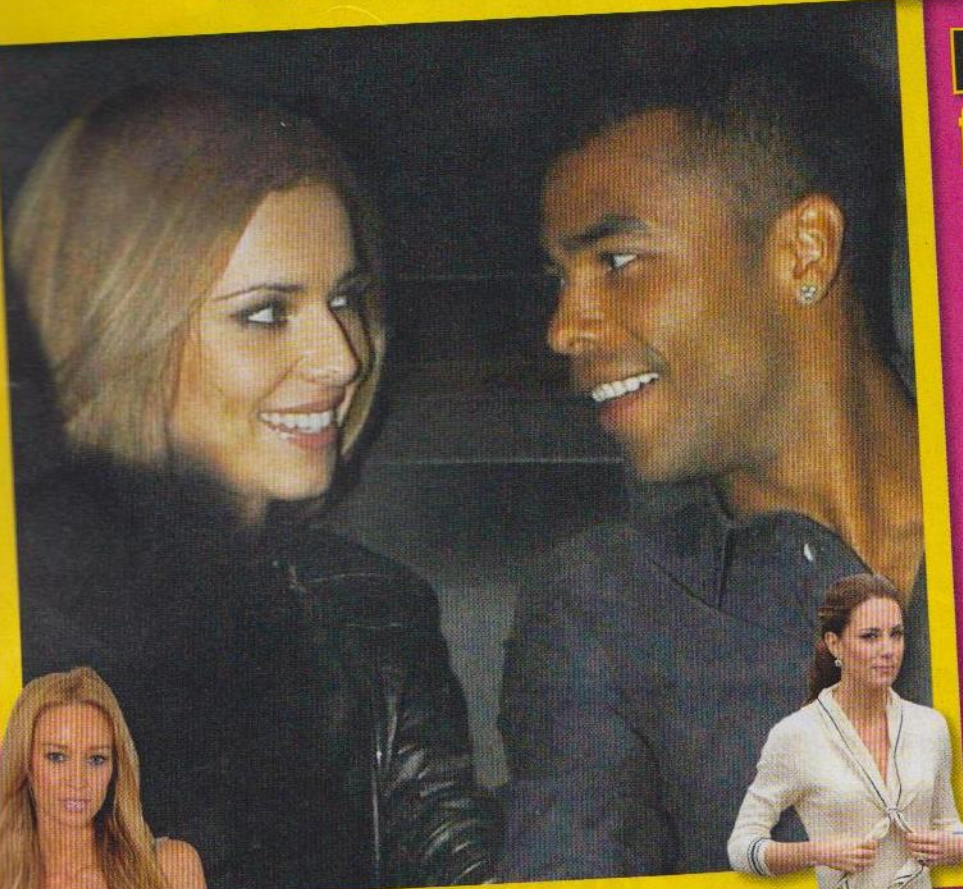

St Tropez Self Tan Bronzing Mousse, £20.43

"I got so bored of the rigmarole involved in applying fake tan that I switched to gradual tan moisturisers. But this mousse has totally got me back in the St Tropez club. It glides on easily and isn't sticky. Within a minute my skin was silky smooth. The next day, I had an even, sun-kissed tan that looked really natural and hadn't rubbed off on my sheets. Love it! Just make sure you use the mitt and don't miss any bits – that's the only time it could go patchy. The only downside is the price."

Rodial Brazilian Tan Dark, £40

"This fake tan obviously gives a very deep, dark colour, but you have to be very careful how you apply it or you will end up covered in streaks like I was! I normally use St Tropez foam and slap it on quite freely and don't end up with streaks but, when I applied this in the same way, I ended up with a very blotchy result. Really disappointing, especially considering the high price."

"This comes with a mitt and plastic gloves, which is helpful as there isn't much room for error with this product. It goes on quite smoothly but when I accidentally spilled some water onto my arm 20 minutes after applying it, it caused a huge streak and I had to frantically try and blend it. The end result was okay-ish but I wouldn't use this again as it's not easy to make it look even and the smell is off-putting."

"This was so easy to apply – I didn't have a mitt or gloves as directed, but it washed off my hands easily. It's a tinted cream and smells lovely. It felt really light and was completely dry within 90 seconds. Make sure you rub it in thoroughly in sections, rather than slathering it all over then rubbing in, as you could get patches. The next day I had a very natural tan and no streaks. The best I've ever used."

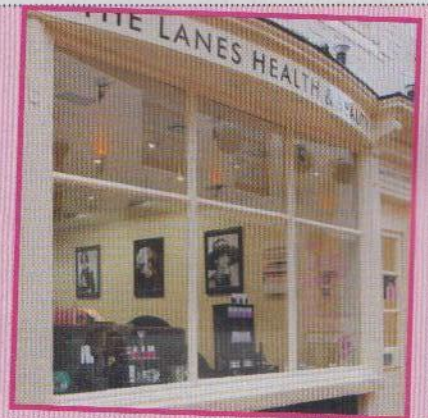
We sent news editor Lisa Jarvis to try out this salon in Brighton
